## 6: 12

All things are I\_\_\_\_\_\_for me-this is what the Corinthian Christians were saying as they said, "As long as we believe in the Messiah, it doesn't matter how we live- they were turning their liberty in Christ into license to sin.

v. 12b: "Mastered" = no sin is more e\_\_\_\_\_\_ than sexual sin. The more it is indulged in the more it controls you and takes from you.
