<b>15:1</b> :
"another sign"=this relates back to Chapter 12 which revealed 2 signs: Israel and satan.
This is a p to the final judgments that start in Chapter 16.
"plaque"= word literally means w or b
15: 2:
"sea mingled with fire= "sea" usually refers to p and "sea of glass" could refer to the word of God.
"fire"= trials of p the saints who become Christinas endure during the Tribulation.
"victory"= these tribulation saints have not lost-they are winners!
1 Cor. 15: 55-57
They receive the victor's crown James 1: 12 and will reign with God for eternity.
Rev. 15: 3-4
They sing the song of victory over their enemy, which is the Song of Moses in Exodus. 15: 1-21 of their victory over Pharoah and a new Song of the Lamb of victory over Babylon.
"fear" r for God
Rev. 15: 5-6

The temple and tabernacle on earth were modeled after the ones in heaven.

The ark of the covenant, Rev. 11:19 is in heaven.

Unlike the earthy temple, the most holy of holies place was open because now nothing obscures God's glory.

In the earthly temple, only the High Priest, once a year, could enter the Holy of Holies for redemption of sin.

But in heaven, no sinful people dwell so the holy of holies remains open.

Hebrews 9:23 tells us that the temple and ark give way to the better sacrifice of Christ, the Lamb of God.

"Clothed in linen" = indicates p\_\_\_\_\_\_ garments.

"Bowls" were used in the service of the temple i.e. a bowl of blood was taken by the high Priest one day each year into the holy of holies for the redemption of sin.

These bowls may be connected to the bowls filled with the prayers of the martyrs in Rev 5:8.

They are God's direct response to that plea for Him to avenge their suffering and death.

## Rev. 15: 7-8

The temple is filled with smoke from the middle of the Tribulation till the end. No one will have access to God. God will be dealing with humanity from judgment and no longer from mercy.
