Intro:

Chapter four ends with the 24 elders and four living creatures on their faces before God in worship

Chapter five opens with the focus back on the One sitting on the throne of heaven.

This chapter is the interlude in heaven right before the Great Tribulation comes.

5: 1-4:

Scroll= identified in ancient times as a title deed or last will and testament, an instrument of ownership that could only be opened by the rightful heir

Ezk. 2: 9-10

v. 5: WE were given rulership over the world but we lost that thru sin and submitted our title deed to satan and his demons. We forfeited that right to rule because of sin.

This book is the title deed to the earth, and it is purchased by Christ at His death on the cross.

He alone has the right to open the book.

He is the overcomer.

v. 6: The title deed can only be opened by the rightful heir
