There are several purposes of the Great Tribulation:
 To fulfill p: Dan 9:24 To d satan: Rev 19-20 To p those who take Israels land: Ezk 36 To punish sin/rebellion/h hearts: Isa 24: 1-6 To cause earths inhabitants to seek r: Isa. 26:9
There are 3 primary views that theologians have held concerning the church and its relationship in the Great Tribulation
First, PTribulation View: This view states that the church will go through the entire 7 years of the Great Tribulation and then be raptured at its conclusion.
This view teaches that the church and the nation of Israel are the same- in that the church is the "spiritual Israel." Since they are the same, the church goes through the GT in this time the OT calls, "the time of Jacob's trouble."
Second, MTribulation View: that the church will go through the first half of the GT, then be raptured and then at the close of the second half of the Great Tribulation, it will return with Christ
Third, PTribulation View- the church is raptured prior to the start of the Great Tribulation, remains in heaven for the 7-year Tribulation and then returns with Christ at His second coming
The Church

God takes out the church and then deals with Israel as a people/nation.

1 Cor 10: 31-33

1 Thess. 5:9: the rod "appointed" = destined. God has not destined the church for wrath. His wrath comes on Israel and the disobedient Gentile nations.

There are three series of judgments in Revelation:

One of the effects of the Tri	bulation will be that the solar system will be thrown into chaos		

and objects like 99942 Apophis will careen wildly off orbit hitting the earth exploding, destroying cities, triggering massive tidal waves.

The suspension of the laws of the universe now held together by the will and power of God will create tsunamis, earthquakes of a severity never before experienced on earth.

Three: The B_____ Judgments

These are poured out near the close of the seven-year Tribulation. Sores erupt on people's bodies; the sea is turned to blood killing every creature in it; fire pours down on humanity and the earth be placed into total darkness; 100-pound hailstones begin to fall.... And then Jesus Christ returns.
