The Tribulation begins with a false deceptive peace together with a counterfeit spirituality and false religion

6: 3-4: Rider on a red horse who shatters this false peace the antichrist brought about initially

"**Underneath the altar" =** lives given for the sake of the gospel- they plea to God to deal with evil once and for all

Martyrs = witness -they were slain by the enemy because of their witness to the truth of God and the message of Jesus Christ.

In spite of all this, people still choose not to repent and submit their hearts to God. They pray to the rocks rather than to God.

It is a scene of never before experienced catastrophe and disaster in which people are all looking for a crevice to hide in.
