Message Seven: A Mark is Made

Intro:

The judgment of God against injustice is reaching fevered pitch levels unknown to date in human history.

At the close of chapter six those watching God's unfolding judgment cry out, "Who is able to stand through all this?" (Rev 6:17)

As Christ's hand lingers on the seventh seal (revealed in chapter 8), there is an interlude in heaven.

Chapter 7 reveals that two distinct groups of people will stand: One group, located on earth, will stand under the protection of God because of the seal of God upon their foreheads and another group, located in heaven, having been martyred at the hands of God's enemies will stand in heaven before God's throne praising and worshipping God in contrast to the out-of-control panic on earth.
